For many decades, the Lancaster High School Band has been an active and visible part of the Lancaster community. The band program takes great pride in "giving back" by performing and volunteering. As a result of this close connection, the band program has been very fortunate over the years to receive great community support. The many performing ensembles at Lancaster High School are seen regularly at parades, football and basketball games, community events, and gatherings. We are convinced that the Lancaster Bands have a prominent and irreplaceable role in our city and that it is our responsibility to share the joy of music with our local audiences.

The 2015-2016 school year was another exciting year for our band members. During the fall marching band season, the Band of Gold supported our football team at all of their games and participated in several local competitions. The band received numerous awards and honors for performance excellence. The culmination of the season was the band's 35th consecutive appearance at the Ohio Music Education Association State Marching Band Finals where the band earned the top rating of "Superior". Over the winter, the band traveled to Florida to represent Lancaster by performing for tens of thousands in the Magic Kingdom at Disney World.

In addition to the great success of our marching band program, all three concert bands have shown tremendous musical growth in recent years. This past year, the Freshman Band earned unanimous "Superior" ratings at the District Adjudicated Event, the first time in school history the third band has achieved this honor. In May 2015, Symphonic Band was rated "Superior" at the state level, marking a first for the second Lancaster High School concert band. This spring, the top concert band, Wind Ensemble, earned the highest rating from all adjudicators at both the district and state level. This marked the first "Superior" rating for this performing group in 22 years.

The Lancaster band program also had numerous soloists and small ensembles participate at Solo and Ensemble Adjudicated Event, which allowed our students to become more independent as musicians. Throughout the spring, the Percussion Ensemble and Swinging Gales gave several exciting performances for our community.
